# Frankfurt

Our anniversary conference kicked off with a half-day conference packed with insights: from keynotes and panel discussions to a final anniversary reflection – all moderated by our CEO **Susan Spinner**, **CFA** and **Dr. Andreas Sauer**, **CFA**, Founder and Principal of ansa capital management GmbH.

After a warm welcome from our Supervisory Board Chair, **Jens Kummer**, **CFA**, we launched into our keynote sessions.





## **Keynotes**

Setting the stage for the anniversary celebration, our keynote speakers shared their expert perspectives on global markets and investment strategies:

**Prof. Dr. Thomas Mayer, CFA**, founding director of the Flossbach von Storch Research Institute and former Chief Economist of Deutsche Bank, and is among Germany's leading economic voices.

**Antti Ilmanen**, Principal and Global Co-Head of the Portfolio Solutions Group at AQR Capital Management, bringing years of experience advising major institutional investors worldwide.



#### Global Economies and Markets

In his keynote, Thomas Mayer discussed global fiscal fragility, the resilience of US productivity, and the impact of Trumponomics on trade.

He highlighted risks from tar-

iff policies, and potential financial repression, while noting that high US productivity continues to support American Exceptionalism and also described how fiscal pressure could shape the future of capital markets, potentially favoring real assets over nominal ones.

#### **Capital Market Returns**

Our keynote speaker Antti Ilmanen discussed the risks of a "rearview-mirror" approach, where past performance leads to overconfidence in US equities, risky assets, and private investments, while undervaluing diversifiers. Ilmanen con-



trasted objective forecasts with subjective investor expectations and stressed that careful, forward-looking analysis is essential to navigate valuations and risk premia, particularly in US versus non-US equity markets.

## **Geopolitical Insights**

Following the two keynotes, **Nicholas FitzRoy**, Partner and Senior Europe Analyst at Signum Global Advisory, shared insights on how shifting geopolitical dynamics are reshaping Europe's economic and political landscape. FitzRoy discussed challenges arising from renewed great-power competition, potential trade tensions with the US and China, and how national competitiveness and upcoming elections may shape Europe's strategic path.







## **Innovation and Capital Panel**

Our panel featured an engaging discussion on the evolving investment landscape. **Dagmar Bottenbruch, CFA**, investor and advisor in the European startup and fintech space, served as expert panelist, while **Torben Skødeberg, CFA**, Co-Founder and Portfolio Manager at Capital Four, shared insights on "Private Debt and the Mittelstand: Unlocking Capital for Growth", highlighting opportunities for financing small and medium-sized enterprises. **Dr. Volker Flögel, CFA**, Head of Investments at Quoniam, spoke on "Smart Capital: How AI Is Reshaping Asset Management", exploring the impact of artificial intelligence on portfolio management and investment processes. With that, our panel offered a multifaceted look at innovation, capital allocation, and emerging trends in European markets, combining practical insights with strategic perspectives from leading experts.

Following his remarks, **Sarah Belenkin-Martin**, Director of Partnerships & Client Solutions for EMEA Societies at CFA Institute, delivered the closing remarks, offering her perspective on the Society's ongoing role, its future priorities, and the opportunities ahead for both its members and the broader CFA community. She also highlighted how the Society's achievements over the past 25 years set a strong foundation for continued innovation, engagement, and professional development. The session provided a reflective close to the conference, leading seamlessly into the following Evening Re-
